**Sat 1 \* Hogan Park to Tacoma to Vashon \* 9:00 AM / 65 miles** \* Kent, Hogan Park (former Russell Road Park) \* **Bring lunch** to eat on Tahlequah ferry \* Flat with some hilly \* Moderate \* I-5 exit 149/149A, SR-516 east, left on Meeker St, left on Russell Road, 1 block to the park. \*

**Sun 2 \* Two Bridges Ride \* 10:00 AM / ~30 miles** \* Seattle, Seward Park picnic shelter \* Café \* Few hills \* Social \* Seward Park is at Lake Washington Blvd S and South Juneau Street in Seattle. The picnic shelter is southeast of the entrance. \* **No Leader**

**Mon 3 \* Group's Choice \* 10:00 AM / ~25 miles** \* Mercer Island, Lid Park top lot \* Café \* Some hills \* Social \* Eastbound: I-90 exit 6, left on Mercer Way, then right onto 72nd Av (by Roanoke Inn), turn right into parking lot before bridge. Westbound: I-90 exit 7, follow Mercer Way, left onto 72nd Av (by Roanoke Inn), turn right into parking lot before bridge. (If parking not available there park south of the trail on SE 22nd St and meet at start point.) \* **No Leader**

**Tue 4 \* Black Diamond \* 10:00 AM / ~45 miles** \* Renton, Cedar River Park \* Café \* Some hills \* Moderate \* I-405 northbound exit 4A (southbound exit 4 then south on Sunset Blvd), east on SR-169 for 0.2 mi, right into park, proceed into parking area near Carco Theater & Community Center. \*

**Wed 5 \* Leader's Choice \* 10:00 AM / ~30 miles** \* Fall City, Park & Ride lot \* Café \* Possible hills \* Social \* I-90 exit 22, Preston-Fall City Road north to Fall City, cross Snoqualmie River bridge, left on SR-203, left into the parking lot. \*

**Thu 6 \* IKEA \* 10:00 AM / 24 miles** \* Tukwila, Community Center \* IKEA, Renton \* Flat \* Social \* I-5 (Southbound) Exit 156, right on Interurban Ave (for 0.6 mile). [I-5 (Northbound), Exit 156 (keep right to stay on ramp to first exit), left on Interurban Ave.] Turn right on 42nd Ave S over Duwamish. Turn right on 124th and park in NE section of parking lot. \* **No Leader**

**Sat 8 \* Arlington \* 10:00 AM / 44 miles (or 30 option)** \* Snohomish, Centennial Trailhead \* Café (option picnic) \* Railroad grades \* Social \* US-2/SR-9 to Snohomish, east on 2nd Ave, left on Maple, 4 blocks to trail. Park on Maple near intersection with Pine. \* NOTE: Option for shorter ride is **bring lunch** for Lake Cassidy \*

**LUNCH:** Food may be purchased at the planned lunch stop unless the ride leader specifies to **bring lunch**.

**Sun 9 \* Bicentennial to Bogey's \* 10:00 AM / 31 miles** \* Tukwila, Bicentennial Park \* Bogey's Public House, Auburn G C \* Flat \* Social \* I-405 exit 1, south on West Valley Hwy, right on Strander Blvd, cross river, immediate right into the park. For car parking go past shelter and small traffic circle. \*

**Mon 10 \* Fast Ferry to Kingston \* 9:15 AM / ~30 miles** \* Seattle, Colman Ferry Terminal \* Some hills \* Café \* Social \* Ferry terminal (Pier 52) is at 801 Alaskan Way in Seattle. Meet at loading point for the ferry. \* NOTES: Kingston on the 9:35 AM Kitsap Fast Ferry and return by regular Winslow Ferry. \*

**Tue 11 \* Tacoma \* 10:00 AM / ~40 miles** \* Auburn, Brannan Park \* Café \* Significant hill \* Moderate \* SR-167 south to 15th St NW exit, east on 15th, left on Auburn Way, right on 28th St NE to the park. \*

\* **No Leader Tours** - Someone must record names of the tour participants and submit the list for mileage credit.

Pace: SLOW - 10 mph & below, SOCIAL - 10 to 13 mph, MODERATE - 13 to 16 mph, FAST - 16 mph & above

**Wed 12 \* Lincoln Park to Port Orchard (Woods # 44) \* 9:15 AM / 29 miles** \* West Seattle, Lincoln Park North Lot \* Lunch in Port Orchard \* Some hills \* Social \* I-5 exit 163/163A, west on West Seattle Freeway, continue Fauntleroy Way SW as Freeway ends. Parking lot is in the 8200 block of Fauntleroy Way. \* NOTE: Take the 9:30 ferry to Southworth. \*

**Thu 13 \* Brannan Park to Flaming Geyser SP \* 10:00 AM / 30 miles** \* Auburn, Brannan Park \* **Bring lunch** \* River grade \* Slow-Social \* SR-167 south to 15th St NW exit, east on 15th, left on Auburn Way, right on 28th St NE to the park. \* **No Leader**

**Sat 15 \* Ravensdale to Enumclaw \* 10:00 AM / 41 miles** \* Ravensdale, Ravensdale Park \* **Bring lunch** for park \* Some hills \* Moderate \* I-405 northbound exit 4A, (southbound exit 4 then south on Sunset Blvd), east on SR-169 (Maple Valley Rd), left on Kent-Kangley Rd, right on 272nd Ave SE. Meet by the rest rooms. \*

**Sun 16 \* Cedar River Trail to Maple Valley Grange \* 10:00 AM or 9:45 AM / ~30 miles or 20 miles** \* Renton, Cedar River Park \* Pancake Brunch \* Some hills \* Moderate or Social \* I-405 northbound exit 4A (southbound exit 4 then south on Sunset Blvd), east on SR-169 for 0.2 mi, right into park, proceed into parking area near Carco Theater & Community Center. \* NOTES: Brunch \$6.00 includes ham, eggs, beverage and unlimited pancakes. Social pace starts at 9:45 and return on trail. Leader may take Moderate riders on a longer return route. \*

**Mon 17 \* Golden Gardens (Ballard) \* 10:00 AM / ~35 miles** \* West Seattle, Jack Block Public Access (Alki) \* **Bring Lunch** for park \* Couple of hills \* Social \* I-5 exit 163/163A, west 2.3 miles on West Seattle Freeway, Harbor Ave Exit north, in about 0.9 mile turn right through the Jack Block Access red-top arch and meet by the restroom. \*

**Tue 18 \* Leader's Choice \* 10:00 AM / ~40 miles** \* Kent, Hogan Park (former Russell Road Park) \* Café \* Possible hills \* Moderate \* I-5

exit 149/149A, SR-516 east, left on Meeker St, left on Russell Road, 1 block to the park. \*

**Wed 19 \* Redmond \* 10:00 AM / 30 miles** \* Issaquah, City Hall \* Palmers \* Nearly flat \* Social \* I-90 exit 17, south on Front Street, left on Sunset, first right onto 1st Ave. S. Use public parking near the city hall / police station. \* NOTE: Taking trail both ways. \*

**Thu 20 \* Marymoor to Lake Forest Park \* 10:00 AM / 25 miles** \* Redmond, Marymoor Park (trailhead) \* Café or picnic \* Flat \* Social \* SR-520 Lake Sammamish Way exit, follow signs to the park. Park in first area on the left. Car parking fee is \$1. \* **No Leader**

**Sat 22 \* Group's Choice \* 10:00 AM / ~30 miles** \* Tukwila, Community Center \* Café \* Some hills \* Social \* I-5 (Southbound) Exit 156, right on Interurban Ave (for 0.6 mile). [I-5 (Northbound), Exit 156 (keep right to stay on ramp to first exit), left on Interurban Ave.] Turn right on 42nd Ave S over Duwamish. Turn right on 124th and park in NE section of parking lot. \* **No Leader**

**Sun 23 \* Leader's Choice \* 10:00 AM / ~30 miles** \* Mercer Island, Lid Park top lot \* Café \* Some hills \* Social \* Eastbound: I-90 exit 6, left on Mercer Way, then right onto 72nd Av (by Roanoke Inn), turn right into parking lot before bridge. 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**Wed 26 \* Both bridges \* 10:00 AM / ~30 miles** \* Mercer Island, Lid Park top lot \* Café \* Some hills \* Social \* Eastbound: I-90 exit 6, left on Mercer Way, then right onto 72nd Av (by Roanoke Inn), turn right into parking lot before bridge. Westbound: I-90 exit 7, follow Mercer Way, left onto 72nd Av (by Roanoke Inn), turn right into parking lot before bridge. (If parking not available there park south of the trail on SE 22nd St and meet at start point.) \*

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**Thu 27 \* Alki \* 10:00 AM / 33 miles \*** Tukwila, Bicentennial Park \* Alki \* Flat \* Social \* I-405 exit 1, south on West Valley Hwy, right on Strander Blvd, cross river, immediate right into the park. For car parking go past shelter and small traffic circle. \* **No Leader**

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**Sat 29 \* Foothills Trail to South Prairie \* 10:00 AM / 32 miles** \* Puyallup, East Puyallup/Meeker Trailhead \* **Bring lunch** \* River grade \* Social \* From southbound SR-167, exit to SR-410 E, 2nd ramp to right for SR-162 (south toward Orting) for 0.5 miles, after crossing Puyallup River and take next right on 80th St E and drive west 0.6 miles to East Puyallup/Meeker Trailhead on left. \*

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**Sun 30 \* Ravensdale to Enumclaw \* 10:00 AM / ~38 miles** \* Ravensdale, Ravensdale Park \* Café \* Hilly \* Social \* I-405 northbound exit 4A, (southbound exit 4 then south on Sunset Blvd), east on SR-169 (Maple Valley Rd), left on Kent- Kangley Rd, right on 272nd Ave SE. Meet by the rest rooms. \*

### *Notes*

**Road closure:** From the Old Fishing Hole Park in Kent to the underslung pedestrian bridge under SR-516, Frager Rd will be closed for reconstruction. **The bottom line is to use the trail on the east side of the Green River in this area.** The project is the Downey Farm Restoration Project and this phase is expected to take about 3 months.
